State Scholastic 7 SS: Time controls vary per section in the state scholastic. Check www.swchess.com for exact round times. Play all seven rounds, No Elimination.

Collegiate (5 SS) Collegiate is G/90 + 30 sec inc. Rds Saturday 9 am, 1:30pm, 6 pm. Sun 9 am and 1:45 pm. One ½ point bye if requested before end of Rd 2 and before full-point bye awarded.

Eligibility: College section is open to any college student. State Scholastic is open only to Texas Residents or players attending school in Texas. If you go to middle school or junior high you must play in one of the middle school sections. If you go to high school you must play in one of the high school sections. Special rules for which sections to play are at www.swchess.com or TCA Bylaws, Article IX, Section 1E. Players cannot play up. Players must be members of the United States Chess Federation. See www.uschess.org/join. Texas Chess Association membership is required, a tournament membership is included in the entry fee.

Registration: Friday, 2/11, 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. and Saturday, 2/12, 7:00-7:45 a.m. Saturday registration may require a ½ point Round 1 bye. On Friday 9 pm through 10 pm, players and coaches may go to the computer room and check that all their information is entered correctly.

College (1):	Southwest Collegiate: 1 college section.
High School[grades 9-12] (2):	High School Championship and High School Junior Varsity (rated under 1000)
Middle School [6-8/9](3):	MS Championship, MS Junior Varsity (U900) and MS Novice (Under 600)
Elementary [K-5/6] (3):	Elementary Championship, Elementary Junior Varsity (U800) and Elementary Novice (U500)
Primary [preK-3] (2):	Primary Championship, and Primary Junior Varsity (U700)
K-1 [preK - 1](1) :	K - 1 Championship.

Open only to TX residents and schools (except college which is opened to any college student).

Scholastic Prizes: Trophies to top 20 individual and top 15 teams in each section (top 4 players per team compose team score). Plus score awards to players who score 4 or more points and do not otherwise win a trophy. Participation medals to all players who finish the tournament.

Collegiate Prizes Collegiate has some cash prizes. See www.swchess.com. Plaques to top 10 individuals and top 5 teams.

UTD

Winner of High School Championship section will receive a 4-year scholarship to The University of Texas at Dallas (contingent on meeting entrance and other requirements). In case of ties, UTD is the judge on who wins the scholarship.
